The Laboratory of Internet Computing at the Department of Computer Science of the University of Cyprus offers a number of internship positions and work experience opportunities for undergraduate and postgraduate students. Internship opportunities are typically available for periods ranging from 6 weeks to 2 months, and selected annual placements, in areas such as:

- Data analysis and knowledge extraction on the World Wide Web.
- Development of applications in Cloud Computing, Edge Computing, and Internet of Things (IoT) environments.

REQUIREMENTS

- Candidates should be enrolled in an undergraduate or postgraduate (Master) program in Computer Science or Computer Engineering, or a related scientific field.
- Strong programming and operating system skills (Java, Linux, Python) for application and service development.
- Knowledge of Software Engineering methodologies and tools.
- Very good knowledge of English and/or Greek language.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The candidate will be integrated into the research team of the Internet Computing Laboratory and will conduct research and software development in cutting-edge technologies within the scope of the Laboratory's projects. The candidate's duties include i) completing assigned projects, ii) collaborating with other members of the Laboratory, iii) making scientific contributions to research program topics, iv) preparing technical reports in English, v) consistency to agreed deadlines, and vi) submitting weekly progress reports punctually.

INTERNSHIP CONDITIONS

Positions are available both on a full-time and part-time basis. Medical coverage is not provided. The internship period ranges from 6 weeks to 2 months, with selected placements lasting one year, starting on June 6, 2024.

APPLICATIONS

For expressions of interest, candidates should submit the following by May 31, 2024:

- Curriculum vitae in English.
- Brief (not exceeding 300 words) cover letter describing their academic and research interests and experience.
- Copy of Detailed Transcript of undergraduate (B.Sc.) or graduate (M.Sc.) level.
